

Application Information for 2020 Junior Women's Civic Club (3) \$2,000 Scholarships

Since its inception in 1946, the Junior Women's Civic Club (JWCC) has been serving the needs of the community by supporting the areas of art, civics, education and health. Over that time span, the club has distributed over \$500,000 in scholarships.

The members of the Junior Women's Civic Club believe that meaningful volunteer work provides an invaluable learning experience for students while providing interaction with members of the community. This year, through its scholarship program, JWCC will continue to support female students who volunteer, who have proven themselves academically and who have a financial need.

The individual scholarship amount is \$2,000.00. Three such scholarships will be awarded this year. Payment will be made directly to the recipient's Ohio college or university and to be used for the 2020-2021 school year.

The deadline for submitting this application and all supporting materials is **March 21, 2020**.

If mailed, applications must be postmarked by the March 21, 2020 deadline. Applications that are late or incomplete will not be reviewed by the Scholarship Selection Committee.

- Volunteer service
- Minimum of a 2.5 GPA
- Financial need
- May **not** be a child or grandchild of a JWCC member
- **Submission Deadline: Saturday, March 21, 2020**

6. As a high school senior, a copy of your letter of acceptance from the Ohio college/university of your choice.
7. Name printed on each document submitted.
8. Application and all supporting materials must be postmarked by March 21, 2020.

Recommendation Letters

You are required to submit **two** (2) letters of recommendation from persons familiar with your academic, professional, or volunteer activities. These letters must NOT come from relatives. The letters of recommendation must accompany your application.

Transcripts

As a high school senior, please provide an official stamped and signed transcript through 11th grade, **PLUS** a copy of your report card from the first semester of your senior year*, **AND** a copy of your letter of acceptance from the Ohio college/university you will attend.

**Note: (If first semester senior grades are on your official transcript, a first semester report card is not necessary.)*

Applicant's Certification:

If I receive a Junior Women's Civic Club scholarship I agree to:
